This year the raffle sold close to 600 tickets and raised \$25,000 for the non-profit senior living community, the second highest in its history of the raffle! Carvers' winning ticket was picked at the conclusion of a predrawing cocktail hour that was attended by nearly 100 hopeful ticket holders.
