This generous donation enabled Pickering to purchase much needed equipment and Hoyer Lifts – a mobility tool that allows a person to be lifted and transferred with minimum physical effort.

David Woodhead, Pickering Manor CEO, comments, "Having these [Hoyer] lifts is crucial, they can greatly reduce the amount of strain experienced by both the staff and residents. It can also provide a sense of independence for the resident."

Woodhead continues, "Our partnership with the Rotary Golf Outing has been spectacular for us and our residents. The Rotary's support and commitment of 'service above self' truly impacts our residents lives every day. We are extremely appreciative and beyond grateful for their support."
